



Big focus on sports

GRASSROOTS sporting groups will get a kick-along with council's budget providing new clubhouses and playing facilities in the final stage of the Murray Sports Complex redevelopment.

There's also money for building the Kalynda Chase Tennis Centre. The \$3.14 million project is being jointly funded by council (\$1.05 million), Queensland Department of Sport and Recreation (\$1.71 million) and Tennis Queensland (\$376,000) with Urbex Pty Ltd providing the land.

The budget also includes \$125,000 to install lighting at the Lamont Practice Oval at Tony Ireland Stadium.
